Wood Purchasing Policy

The management of Klabin S.A., a pulp and paper company, is based on its Sustainability Policy and on the principles and criteria of the FSC® (Forest Stewardship Council®).

When there is a requirement for the purchase of non-certified wood, Klabin adheres to the norms for controlled wood and exerts its best efforts to avoid the acquisition of wood or fiber in the following categories:

- Wood originating from illegal logging activities.
- Wood, the exploitation of which implies infringement of civil and traditional rights.
- Wood obtained from forests in which the high value of conservation is threatened by extraction activities.
- Wood originating from forests that are being converted into plantations or put to other uses of a non-forestry nature.
- Wood from forests where genetically modified trees have been planted.
