Summary of the Latest Update:

Klabin has established the following guidelines to be followed while planning and carrying out its activities as concerns Climate Change management to reduce its Greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and adapt to climate change:

- Define responsibilities for GHG emissions management; and manage climate-related opportunities and risks;
- Draft, and keep current, the inventory of Scopes 1, 2 and 3 GHG emissions;
- Establish GHG emission goals and disclose them by means of the Sustainability Report or other appropriate media;
- Evaluate the business’s vulnerabilities in the face of Climate Change, integrally with the company’s global risk management, considering: (i) future climate scenarios; (ii) threats and opportunities identification; (iii) evaluating, planning and implementing adaptive measures;
- Promote and encourage energy efficiency;
- Promote and encourage the company’s adaptive capabilities, pursuing partnerships with stakeholders (governments, society, local communities and customers).
- Consider GHG emissions reduction and regulation to combat the effects of Climate Change while devising new projects and processes;
- Promote and encourage the use of renewable fuels, pursuing reduced consumption of fossil fuels;
- Pursue reduced GHG emissions associated with transportation of our products;
- Encourage technological innovation and Research and Development to reduce GHG associated with our activities, and develop solutions to mitigate the impacts of climate change.

- Disclose Climate Change guidelines to the relevant parties.
- Participate in forums and volunteer initiatives connected to the subject and intended to discuss and propose best practices for GHG emissions management and climate change adaptation.
